The Icelandic Swimming Association and Parasport Iceland invites you to the 21st Reykjavík International Games - Swim Meet, January 24th to 26th 2025. The competition will take place in Laugardalslaug in Reykjavík in a 50m, 10-lane pool.

Many international swimmers have participated in the meet through the years, from Norway, Sweden, Denmark, Finland, Faroe Islands, India, Italy, Poland, Czech Republic, Germany, Slovakia, Qatar, USA, and the UK

Internationally experienced referees have been invited to conduct the technical part of the competition and it is a World Aquatics, LEN and IPC approved meet.

Participation in Reykjavík International Games also allows you to plan a training camp for your team before or after the competition. The Icelandic Swimming Association can help with booking training times and accommodation.

Location: Laugardalslaug swimming pool, Sundlaugarvegur 30, 105 Reykjavík, Iceland

Competitors: Reykjavík International Games is open to all swimmers.

Rules: The competition will be conducted under World Aquatics and IPC rules. The competition is approved as a qualifying event for World Aquatics Championships in Singapore 2025 and has IPC licence. Para swimmers will be seeded as per entry time.

Entry deadline: Deadline for preliminary entries is December 13th 2024
Deadline for final confirmation of entries is January 8th 2025
Entries after deadlines are subject to availability and will be charged with late entry fee.

Awards Medals for open and youth category. 3 best male and female swimmers will receive medals.
In addition, winner of each event will receive EUR 50 in open category.

The five best overall performances according to the World Aquatics point table will receive price money as follows:

Best performance: EUR 1.000
2nd best performance: EUR 700
3rd best performance: EUR 400
4th best performance: EUR 200
5th best performance: EUR 100

The best female performance in Para class will receive price money of EUR 500 according to the Icelandic 1000 points system.
The best male performance in Para class will receive price money of EUR 500 according to the Icelandic 1000 points system.

- Qualifying Period:** January 1st 2024 to January 8th 2025.
Entry times must be achieved on long course or converted times from short course (see below)
- Qualifying Times:** Swimmer qualified in one event will be given the opportunity to compete in up to two additional events, if space allows (total of up to three events).
- Withdrawals:** The competition office must be informed of withdrawals in writing.
- Withdrawals from preliminary heats must be handed in at the latest 19:00 the day before.
- Withdrawals from the finals must be handed in, no later than 30 minutes after completion of the heats' session.
- Withdrawals can only be handed in on paper to an official in the competition office or by email to meets@iceswim.is. Failure to hand in withdrawals within these time limits will be treated as DNS.
- 30 EUR or ISK 5000 in penalty fee for DNS during the competition. This will be invoiced to the club.
- Swim down pool** During the competition, swimmers can use the outdoor 8 lane, 50m pool to swim down, as well as for warmup.
- Final call room** 15 minutes before the start of each race, competitors must appear in the final call room located behind the starting blocks and stay there until notified by officials to move to the pool deck. Entry to the final call room is only for competitors that are about to swim and officials.
- Victory ceremony:** Victory ceremonies will be held in the prelims session for youth category and para swimmers. Victory ceremonies for open category will be in the afternoon sessions and will be announced in the meet program and by the competition office. Swimmers must report to the final call room before the victory ceremony. Failure to show up for the victory ceremony will result in a fine of EUR 8 or ISK 1200, invoiced to the club.
- Technical meeting:** Technical meeting will be held on Wednesday, January 22th 2025 at 12:00 noon GMT on Microsoft Teams meeting. Any changes to the meet program and other important information will be announced there. Team contact persons will receive the invitation to the meeting.

REGULATIONS

1. Reykjavik International Games – swimming competition, is held according to World Aquatics rules. The organizer is the Icelandic Swimming Association in cooperation with Parasport Iceland.
2. The competition takes place in an indoor Olympic pool (50m x 25m) and is being run on 8 lanes. Depth is 2m and water temperature is around 27°C.
3. The competition is open to all swimmers and the following age categories apply:

Age categories	Youth	Senior
Male	2010 and younger	2009 and older
Female	2010 and younger	2009 and older

4. Heats will be seeded according to the entry times, without any regards to the swimmers age. We only accept long course times or converted times. Convert times from short course (25m) to long Course (50m) by adding 2% to the entry time from short course.
We only accept times equal to or faster than the standard time which is on the meet program.
5. Heats and finals will be swum in all 50m, 100m, and 200m events. Direct finals will be swum for the 800m and 1500m freestyle events. The 16 fastest swimmers (male and female) of each category from the heats will qualify for the A and B final in 50m and 100m events. For the 200m and 400m events only one heat of 8 swimmers will be swum in the finals.

6. The competition office must be informed of withdrawals in writing.
Withdrawals from preliminary heats must be handed in at the latest 19:00 the day before.
Withdrawals from the finals must be handed in no later than 30 minutes after completion of the heats.
Withdrawals can only be handed in on paper to an official in the competition office or by email to meets@iceswim.is. Failure to hand in withdrawals within these time limits will be treated as DNS.
30 EUR or ISK 5000 in penalty fee for DNS during the competition. This will be invoiced to the club.
7. Medals for open category will be awarded in the finals session. 3 best male and female swimmers will receive medals. Medals for youth category will be awarded in the prelims sessions for 3 best boys and girls. Medals for para swimmers will be awarded in the prelims sessions for 3 best male and female swimmers.

8. Special prizes will be awarded for the five best performances of the meet according to the latest World Aquatics point table as described above. Special gift will be awarded for the best performances for boys and girls in youth category according to the latest World Aquatics point table. Special prizes will be awarded for the best female and best male performance of the meet in para class according to the Icelandic 1000 points system.
9. **Preliminary entries must be received by December 13th 2024.**
Final confirmation of entries must be received by January 8th 2025. Only Splash and WinGrodan entry forms (via Swimrankings or email) can be used to register swimmers. Excel forms should be used where this is not available and is subject to higher entry fee, see below.
Late entry fee is paid when deadlines are not met.

11. **The Entry fee is EUR 8 or ISK 1200** for each individual event. No restitution will be made for absence. **Entry fee must be paid no later than January 17th 2025.** Bank information is listed on the previous pages.
Entries on Excel forms are subject to entry fee of EUR 12 or ISK 1800 per swimmer per event.
Late entry fee is EUR 20 or ISK 3000 for each individual event.

The organizers reserve the right to withdraw entries where entry fee is not paid.
